

MIGRANTS' DEMONSTRATION

against government's racism

and exploitation

Migrants and asylum seekers, women and men, it's not time to be scared anymore. It's time to demonstrate against government's racism which wants us either clandestines or exploited. We take to the streets **against Salvini's law** and its enforcement:

- We don't want to wait for months to have answers from the commissions anymore. We don't accept to receive denials after the persecutions and the violence we suffered in our countries of origin and along our travel. **We don't accept denials** while we are exploited in warehouses and cooperatives, often without contract or with short-term contracts through leasing companies, internships or non-paid works.
- We don't accept the permit to be a **blackmail against migrant women** who, after suffering violence during the travel, are exposed to molestations in the structures, in the houses, in the warehouses and in other workplaces.
- We don't accept that the Municipality denies the **residency**: we want access to social services and sanity. We don't accept the closure of CAS: we don't want to be put in the regional centre of Via Mattei or thrown to the streets because nobody rent to migrants.
- We don't accept the extension of the time to obtain **citizenship**. We don't accept that less and less residence card are granted. We refuse the blackmail imposed by **Bossi-Fini's law** which oblige to prove every year that we have a house, a job and a sufficient income.

While it projects to build new centres for detention and expulsion, this racist government want to transform asylum seekers in cheap labour force, with no rights and with lower and lower wages, just like the migrants who have been living in this country for years. This is why **we want for everybody, migrants and asylum seekers, a residency permit, to move in freedom and build a better life!**
