



# NO VICTIMS, NO FLASH FOR WORK:

**WE ARE MIGRANTS, WOMEN AND MEN**

**WE DEMONSTRATE AGAINST RACISM AND EXPLOITATION ON THE 15<sup>TH</sup> OF FEBRUARY**

We touched land after crossing the sea. In Libya we faced jailers and rapists and in Italy ministers who closed the ports and agreed with those who sold us as slaves. And yet, **we women and men who migrated got here anyway**. On land, however, we must continue to fight so that we do not receive a denial, so that we are not thrown out of reception-system, so that we are not blackmailed, exploited and harassed at work, **so that we do not lose our documents and become illegal immigrants**. For this reason, **on Saturday, February 15, we will take to the streets of Bologna** against racism and exploitation that put our lives in danger again!

**The breakthrough promised by the government never happened.** The humanitarian permit has not been reintroduced and those who have it, risk ending up on the streets. New special permits are rarely granted, and denials are on the increase, while new expulsion centres are under construction and no one talks about Ius soli, Ius culturae and citizenship anymore. Salvini is no longer there, but his decrees are still and they must be cancelled. **That's why we're going to demonstrate! Because we are not, and we don't want to be neither targets of racism nor victims to protect!**

**We have laboriously built a life in this country despite the precariousness of working in factories, warehouses and houses, despite the racism** that justifies lower wages, worse working conditions and higher rents, despite the fact that it is increasingly difficult and expensive to renew a residence permit and obtain citizenship. **We will demonstrate to reject this condition of exploitation! We will demonstrate to say no together! No to the racism that lies in laws, in police headquarters, at work, in homes, in reception centres and on the streets.** We ask everyone, migrants and Italians, to take part: we will take to the streets to take back the freedom we left for, because ours is a battle for everyone!
